B Following and Witnessing

The word **WITNESSING** is often associated with court and jury trials. This is because someone who witnessed something can give **evidence**. They can tell what happened and how, in what way, what was said, who was involved. They can say "I was there!"

Have you ever witnessed anything that you still remember? Something that you think you will never forget?

Very often when we witness something important it changes our life in some way. One of the first people who spoke about **Witnessing** to Jesus was **St Peter**, just after he had received the Holy Spirit on Pentecost Sunday. This is what he said to the crowd:



Men of Israel, listen. Jesus of Nazareth was a man commended to you by God. This man, you took and had crucified. You killed him, but God raised him to life, and all of us are witnesses to that.

Acts 3

As a result of being a witness to all this, Peter's life changed. And how! He left everything to be able to preach to everyone the good news of Jesus. He travelled to other towns to give his witness. After a few years he witnessed by giving up his life for the love of Jesus when he was martyred in Rome.

And me? How can I be a Witness to Him? How and where can I be a witness to Christ in today's world?

D TASK

Having come so far in this Confirmation programme you are now in a position to understand much better if you really want to **FOLLOW** Jesus in your adult life and be his **WITNESS**.
