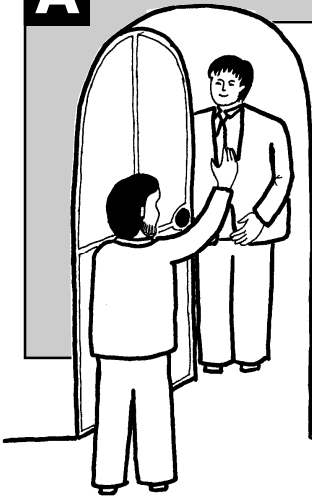

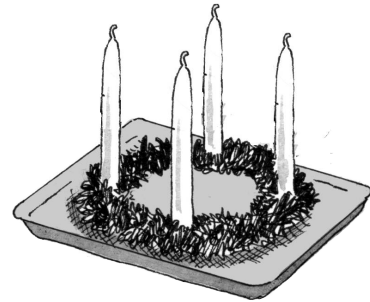

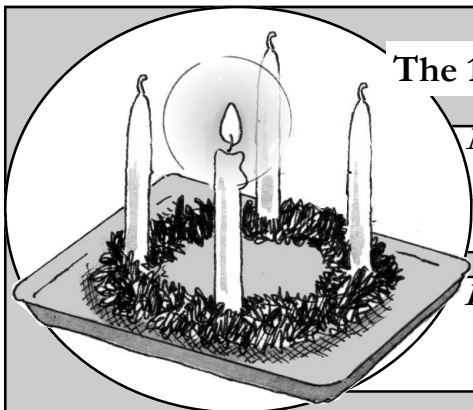

Name three Old Testament prophets.

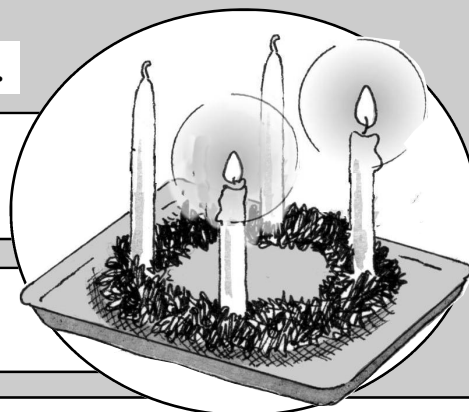
How can I be a Prophet to others this week?

What can I do on the example of John the Baptist?

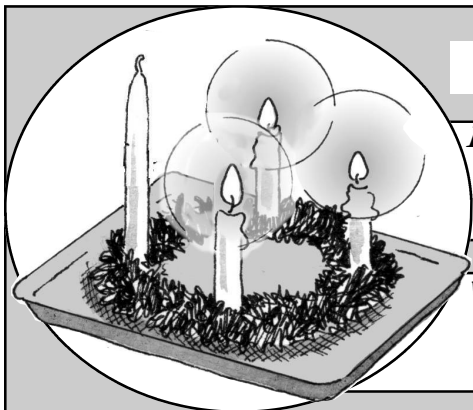


3rd Sunday
