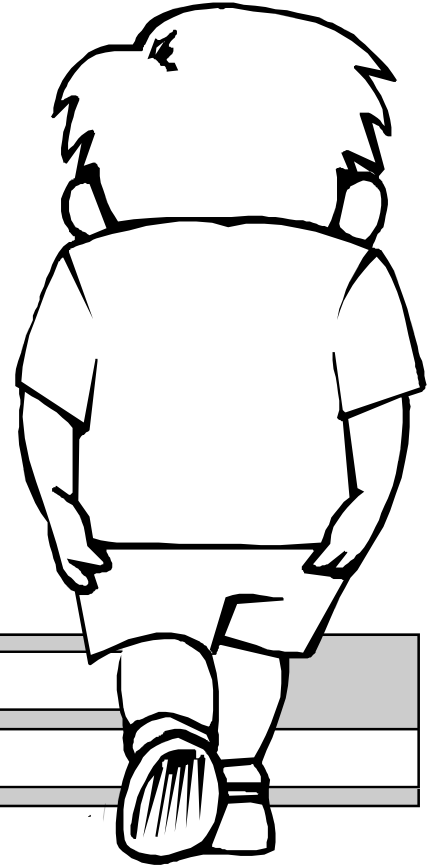

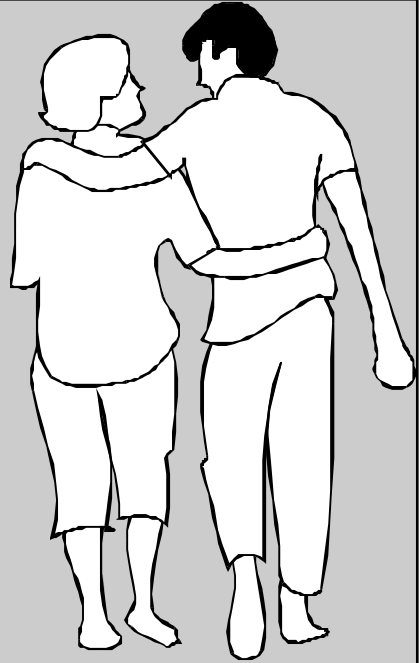
Failure ... **LOOKING AT BOTH SIDES OF THE COIN**
