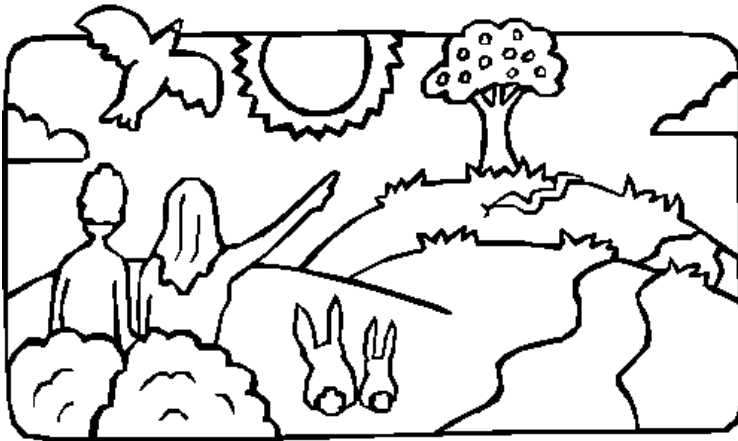
BIBLE READING

GOD'S CREATION

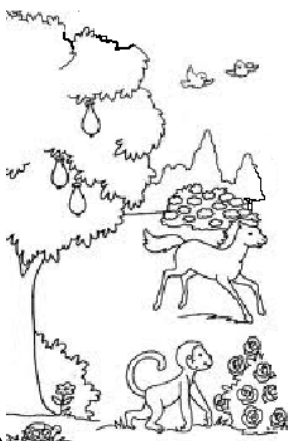
