Groups A, B and C - Saturdays from 3.45 p.m. to 4.45 pm.

We open 15 minutes before each session. Entrance through the Iron Gate, at the back of the church. Each session will last for an hour. Please be on time for the session and collect the children promptly.

Regular attendance is required for children to be able to be presented for First Holy Communion.
