my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore I ask blessed Mary, ever virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God. Amen.

# Individual Confessions / Sacrament of Reconciliation

Meanwhile play quiet music and encourage children to think about getting ready to meet Jesus in Reconciliation and what it means to be truly sorry.

If waiting time is long, plan other activities for children to do while they wait such as for example: making a FRIENDS AGAIN card, or writing their own sorry prayer and drawing picture about the same theme.

# Sharing Peace

*Priest/Leader:* Now as a sign of our willingness to grow in friendship let us offer each other a sign of peace.

# Final Prayer and Blessing

*Priest/leader:* Father, thank you for the gift of friendship.

Thank you for this time together when we are able to express our sorrow for our lack of love in friendship.

May we continue to grow in friendship today and always. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

# **Bible Reading - GOOD FRIENDS** Dramatized - based on 1 Sam 19:2-7

### 3 children to read and act out the following parts.

- This story is taken from the First Book of Samuel: *Narrator:* Jonathan, the son of King Saul, was a really good friend of David and held him in great affection. He warned him:
- My father Saul is looking for a way to kill you; go into Jonathan: hiding; don't let him find you. I will see what the situation is and then tell you.
- Jonathan spoke highly of David to Saul his father and *Narrator:* said:
- The king should not harm his servant David; he's been Jonathan<sup>•</sup> so good to you and he has done many things to help you. He risked his life and he killed the Philistine giant Goliath. Why then sin against innocent people by killing David for no reason?
